## Outreach activities for Students and neighbouring community with the help of VJRC NCC unit



The NCC cadets of the college participate in a variety of events each year, including social work, training exercises, conferences, annual training camps, national camps, etc. This unit took pride in working closely with the affiliated battalion, 39 Bengal Bn NCC, Jadavpur, Kolkata, between the months of June 2017 and May 2018. The cadets' actions and efforts are reflected in this report, but it also serves as a testament to their hard work and dedication in carrying out their tasks in spite of trying or demanding circumstances. Such experience leads to simultaneous holistic development in the cadets. Since 2004, the NCC unit of VJRC has played a crucial role in elevating the institution and the unit in numerous ways. The fact that NCC unit of VJRC has a history of creating law-abiding, disciplined, and successful individuals is evidence of the effort the organization does to ensure that its cadets are successful in all facets of life. Our ongoing efforts to develop each cadet's overall personality will enable them to successfully navigate life's challenges and contribute to society.

### Extension Activities carried out by NCC in session 2017-18

1. Voluntary blood donors are the cornerstone of a safe and adequate supply of blood and blood products. The safest blood donors are voluntary, non-remunerated blood donors from low-risk populations. In 2018-19 session a total of 27 and 2 NCC cadets of VJRC participated as volunteer blood donor at blood donation camp on 23.11.2017 and 05.04.2018 organized at Command Hospital, Kolkata.
2. 35, 20, 25 and 17 NCC cadets of the VJRC NCC Unit participated in mass awareness rally on "cleanliness drive" 2.12.2017, 3.12.2017, 8.12.2017 and 9.12.2017 respectively

4. 5 NCC cadets of the VJRC NCC Unit participated in National Cancer Awareness Day Rally on 7.11.2017
5. 20, 22 and 24 NCC cadets of the VJRC NCC Unit participated in different types of cleanliness drive like cleaning of streets, local hospital premises, back alleys, college campus and maintenance of statues of important persons of national importance on 6.12.2017, 10.12.2017 and 24.12.2017 respectively
6. National Youth Day, which honours Swami Vivekananda's birthday, encourages us to reflect on his writings and incorporate his principles into our own lives. Vivekananda's life and mission were an example to all, and his ideas are spread and discussed on National Youth Day. In 2017-18 session, 19 NCC cadets participated in Youth Day Rally on 12th January 2018 where ideas and principles of Swamiji were displayed for motivate the youth of this country
7. On 21.02.2018, 22 NCC cadets along with other students, faculty members, Non-teaching staffs, and NSS Volunteers of Vijaygarh Jyotish Ray College paid homage to the
