


# Extension activities






Celebration of "Independence Day of India" 2020

5. On 26.01.2021, the NCC cadets participated in salami drill and the national flag was hoisted by the Associate NCC Officer of the college.








#### Partnering with Educational Institutions for long term awareness building programmes with Youth





#### **FOREWORD**






## CELEBRATION OF 6TH INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR YOGA, 2020


