


4. Special Lecture on 'Teenage Girls: Nutritional problem and Contemporary India'



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

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

An awareness program on gender sensitization was organized by the Women Cell of the college on 13th March 2019 in collaboration with SWAYAM. 58 students participated in the seminar.



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


13. Thalassemia Awareness Program

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







14. Cervical Cancer Awareness Camp
