



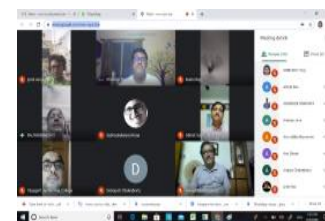
Brief report on the Webinars organized by Vijaygarh Jyotish Ray College

The new respiratory disease (COVID-19) is spreading across the world. India has also reported cases from states and the government is trying to contain the spread of the disease and government has temporarily closed educational institutions. At this situation students are stranded at home, with extremely limited contact with friends and virtually no physical activity. The teaching and meeting of Vijaygarh Jyotish Ray College have moved on classes online to carry on the ongoing syllabus, to stay connected with the students and to continue necessary college actions.

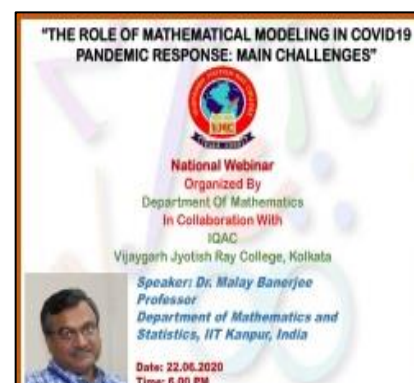


Commerce.”

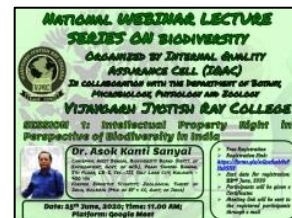
International Webinar for two-days (26th and 28th June, 2020) involved a good number of teachers and students

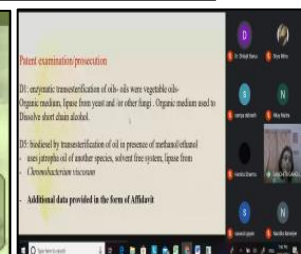

“Education and Natural Disaster”. The sessions were very satisfactory to the participants.

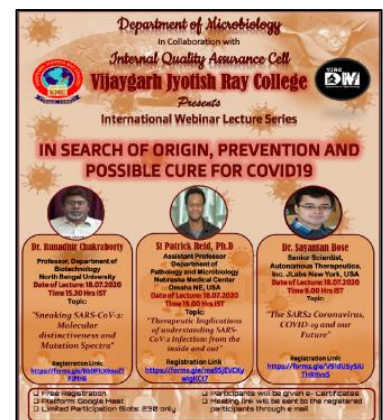
