

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



Based on the result of the All India Competitive Examination for Admission to 25% Seats (100% seats of Dr. RPCAU, Pusa and ICAR-DUs) in Doctoral degree programmes of accredited Universities under ICAR-AU system [SAUs, Central Agricultural Universities, viz. CAU, Imphal, Dr. RPCAU, Pusa, 3 Central Universities (CUs) having faculty of agriculture (BHU, Varanasi, AMU, Aligarh and SASARD, Nagaland University) and the award of ICAR-JRF/SRF(Ph.D.) in Agriculture & Allied Sciences for Academic Session 2021-22, this is to inform that **you have been found eligible to register (Online) for choice filling.** Based on Online Counseling in the subject of your choice, you are likely to be recommended for admission to an accredited subject and College in an accredited University. This will, however be subject to fulfilling of the prescribed eligibility requirements as stipulated in the AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.)-2021 Information Bulletin available at <u>www.icar.nta.nic.in</u> and Online Counseling Brochure available at <u>www.icarexam.net</u>. This will also depend upon the availability of seats at your merit rank and category and verification of documents by the officials of admitting University at the time of counseling and your physical reporting at the finally allotted university for registration/attending the classes or as per the requirements of admitting university. Subject to meeting of prescribed eligibility criteria of UR (Unreserved) category, the SC/ST/Gen-EWS/UPS/OBC/PwD candidates may be allotted seat against the UR category.

Before registering for choice filling, you must ensure that all the eligibility conditions, as specified in the AICE-JRF/SRF(Ph.D.)-2021 Information Bulletin (IB) available on NTA website (<u>www.icar.nta.nic.in</u>) and online counseling brochure, are fulfilled in *toto* including completion of the degree, OGPA/percentage marks scored in Master's Degree examination, etc. (Where OGPA is awarded, equivalence between OGPA and % marks will not be acceptable). Please note that ICAR/Universities will NOT be held responsible for denial of admission to non-eligible candidates. The candidate is advised to read the IB in detail, especially the Item 4.0 (Admission through Online Counselling) of Online Counseling Brochure of AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.)-2021 available at ICAR website (<u>www.icar.org.in,www.icarexam.net</u>) and the requirements contained therein.

Scanned images (JPEG files) of the original documents [mentioned at Item 4.1.1 of AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.)-2021 Online Counseling Brochure] are required to be uploaded on the counseling portal at the time of counseling.

Candidates reporting for the admission must have Degree/Provisional Degree Certificate (PDC) of completion of Master's degree programme at the time of online verification of document by the allotted university. The candidates who do not have the Degree/PDC, have to mandatorily produce a certificate from the Registrar of the concerned university specifically indicating that *the candidate has been awarded Final OGPA/Percentage of marks at the end of final semester/year and he/she shall be completing all the requirements including thesis submission and completion of viva-voce for the award of Masters degree before 31.12.2021 along with mentioning the likely date of issuance of PDC/Degree to the candidate.*

The candidate should note that having 4/5 (B.V.Sc.& A.H.)/6 (10+6, B.Sc. Ag.) years' UG degree is the essential requirement for admission to Master degree programmes. The candidates having passed with 3 years' UG degree programme are not eligible for admission through AICE-JRF/SRF (Ph.D.)-2021 except at IARI and NDRI in few courses.

In case any degree from a particular college/university is not considered for admission by an Agricultural University on account of a particular college/university being derecognized by VCI/UGC, or due to any court directives (present or future), ICAR will not be responsible for admitting students of that college/university in the Universities not willing to admit such candidates.

The candidates passed out from private agricultural colleges/universities not accredited by ICAR, even though affiliated to public funded/Govt. institutions, were notified through Information Bulletin, as not eligible to appear in AICE-JRF/SRF(Ph.D.) examination. Therefore, if any of such candidates have appeared in the examination and their scores declared by NTA, are not eligible to participate in the counseling. Fellowship would be granted only when the candidate seeks admission after counselling and pursues Ph.D. degree in an AU other than the AU from where he/she has completed Bachelor's or Master's degree as indicated in the Information Bulletin and Online Counseling Brochure. 

This Award Letter is being issued to you for activation of fellowship under DBT-JRF programme. General terms and conditions governing the DBT – JRF fellowship are given below:

- Admission to Ph.D. Programme: Fellowship shall be tenable at any recognized host university/ institution in India, where the candidate registers for Ph.D. programme. Admission procedure shall be as per the rules and regulations of the host university/ institution. While considering the fellowship appointment, original documents related to the eligibility criteria and caste/category (if applicable) of the candidate must be verified by the appointing authority of the host university/ institution.
- 2. Tenure of Fellowship: Total tenure of fellowship shall not exceed five (5) years from the 'Start Date' of fellowship including the tenure of fellowship awarded by any other funding agency/institution. 'Start Date' of fellowship shall be either the date of joining the Ph.D. programme or date of issuance of award letter, whichever is later. 'End Date' of fellowship shall be either date of completion of five (5) years of fellowship tenure or date of Ph.D. viva-voce or date of resignation by fellow or cancellation of fellowship by DBT, whichever is earlier. On completion of two (2) years as 'DBT-JRF', fellow shall be considered for upgradation as 'DBT-SRF' depending on assessment of the satisfactory progress of the fellow.
- 3. Process for Fellowship Activation: Candidate can activate fellowship on joining a Ph.D. programme. Candidate who is already enrolled for Ph.D. programme, can activate the fellowship on receipt of the award letter. For fellowship activation, candidate must register on DBT-JRF Online Portal <u>www.dbtjrf.gov.in</u> and follow the detailed process for registration of host university/institution, confirmation of Ph.D. guide/supervisor and submission of requisite documents. On verification of the above, fellowship shall be activated under DBT-JRF programme.
- 4. Timeline for Fellowship Activation: Candidate must submit requisite documents for activation of fellowship on online DBT-JRF portal within two (2) months of Joining the Ph.D. Programme. In case, there is a delay in submission of documents by the candidate beyond two (2) months from Joining the Ph.D. Programme, then date of upload of documents on online DBT-JRF Portal shall be the Start Date of fellowship.
- 5. Emoluments under Fellowship: Fellow shall be designated as 'DBT-JRF' with consolidated fellowship of Rs. 31,000/- per month and contingency grant of Rs. 30,000/- per year. Fellow shall be eligible to avail House Rent Allowance (HRA), if institutional accommodation is not provided by the host university/ institution. Fellowship, contingency and HRA (if applicable) shall be released on timely submission of prescribed documents on online DBT-JRF Portal.
- Compliance with Guidelines: Issuance of this award letter and activation of fellowship does not guarantee the emoluments under the fellowship and this award shall be subject to compliance to the DBT-JRF Programme Guidelines as applicable from time to time.
- 7. Validity of Award Letter: Validity of this award letter shall be for two (2) years from the date of issuance of award letter for activation of fellowship, beyond which the validity of this award letter shall lapse.
