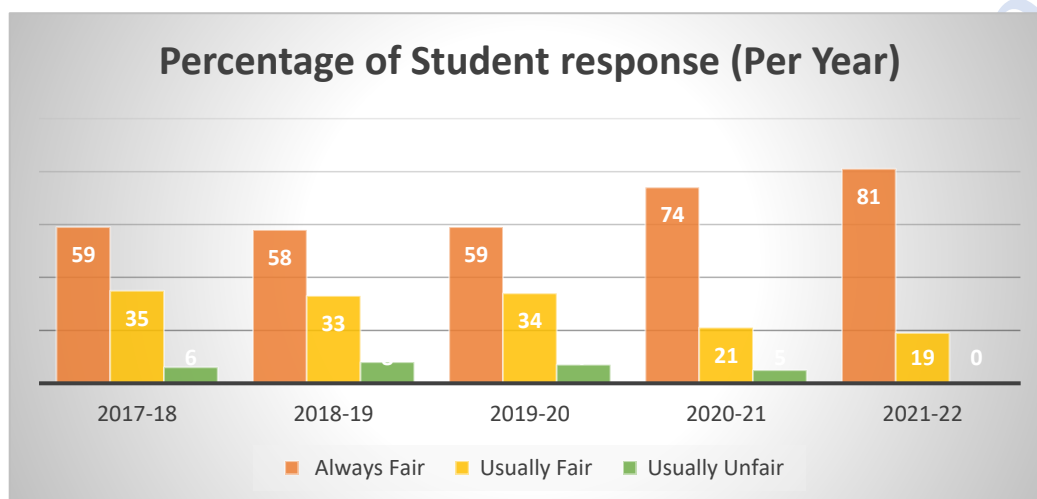

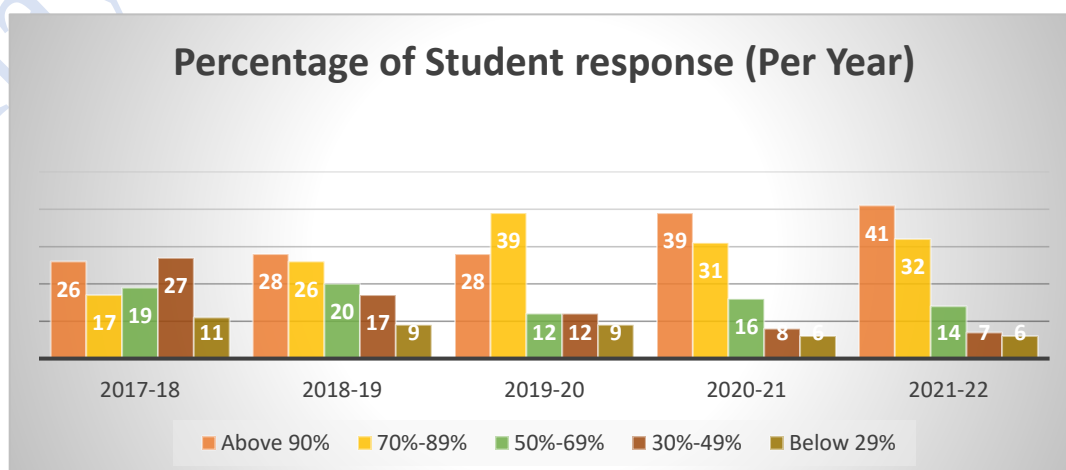

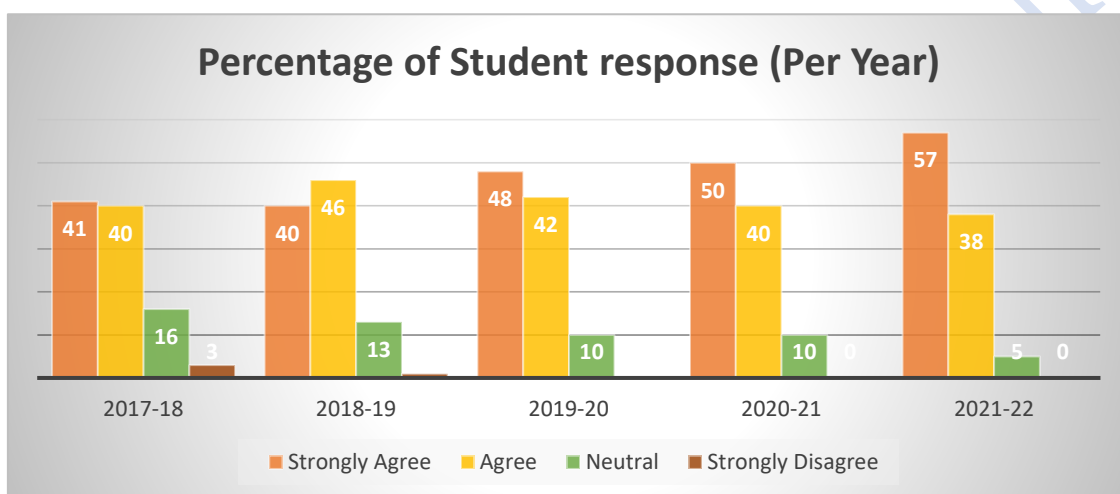

ANALYSIS:

1. Based on student response teachers were trying to complete the whole syllabus in the class. It is reflected by the increasing percentage of the covered syllabus over the periods. During 2021-22, 83% of the students reported that teachers were able to cover 85%-100% syllabus.
2. Over the year teachers were able to communicate with students effectively. In the year 2021-22, 77% students respond that teachers were able to communicate them effectively.
3. Most of the students reported the fairness of the internal evaluation process by their college teachers. In the year 2021-22, 81% students reported that the fairness of the internal evaluation process by the college teachers were 'always fair'.
4. Each year the performance in assignments is discussed with students, though there is a variation. For example, in the year 2021-22, 49% students reported that their performance on assignments was discussed with them 'every time', while 32% reported "Usually", 16 % reported "occasionally" and only 3% reported that it happened rarely.

5. Most of the students reported that college took an active interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities for them. An insignificant percentage of student over the years reported that these activities 'never' happened.
6. More than 50% of students reported that teachers informed them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes. For example, during the period 2021-22, 53% of the students reported that this happened 'every time', 38% reported it happened 'usually', 8% reported it happened 'occasionally' & only 1% reported it happened 'rarely'.
7. When students were asked about whether their teacher illustrated the concepts through examples and applications or not, most of the students reported that in affirmation. In the year 2021-22, more than 60% of students reported that it happened 'every time'.
8. Most of the students over the years reported that the institution has made an effort to engage students in the monitoring, reviewing and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
9. Most of the students reported that the institute/teacher used student-centric methods such as experimental learning, participative learning & problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences. For example, during 2021-22, 60% students reported that it happened to a 'great extent', 33% reported that it happened 'moderately', 6% students reported it happened 'somewhat' and only 1% students reported it happened 'very little'.
10. More than 50% of students on average 'strongly' agreed that their teachers encouraged them to participating in extra-curricular activities over the years.
11. Most of the students reported that efforts were made by the institution/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the job market. For example, in 2021-22, 51% reported that it happened to a 'great extent', 24% student reported it happened 'moderately', 25% reported it happened 'somewhat'.

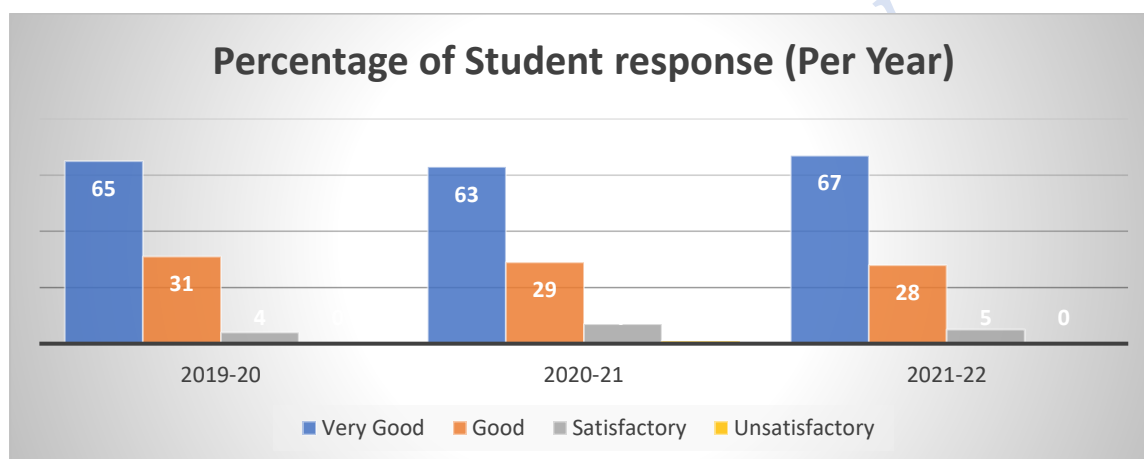
12. As per student responses over the years (2017-18 to 2021-22) it is clear that the ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. used by the teachers while teaching are increasing significantly . For example, during 2017-18, 57% students responded that less than 50% teachers used ICT Tools while teaching, which declined to 27% students in 2021-22.
13. Most of the students strongly agreed that the overall quality of the teaching learning process in their institution is very good. For example, in 2021-22, 57% of students strongly agreed that the quality of the teaching-learning process is very good, 38% of students agreed with the view and the 5% remained neutral.

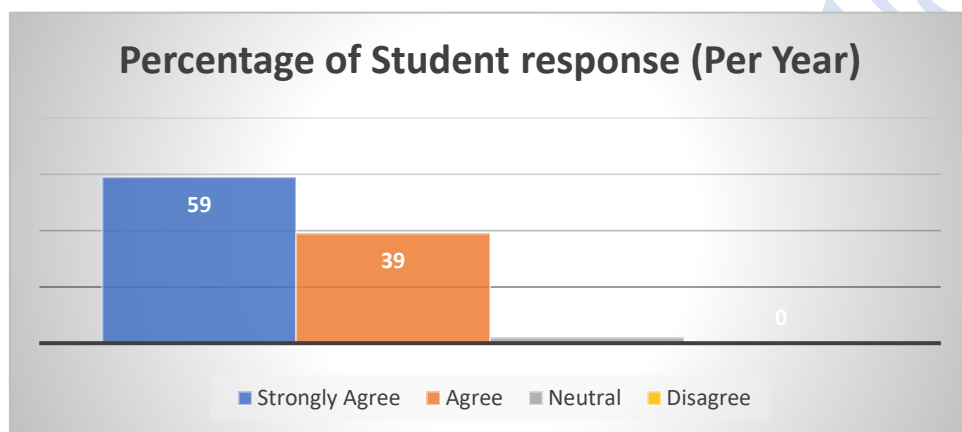

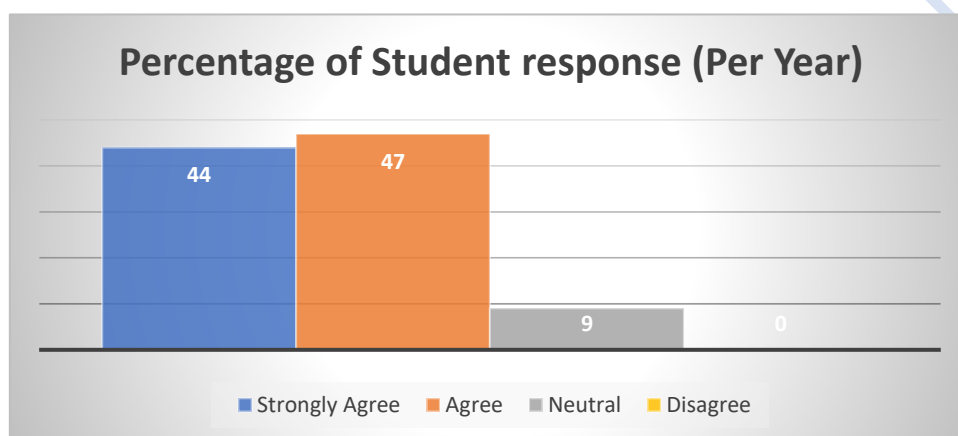

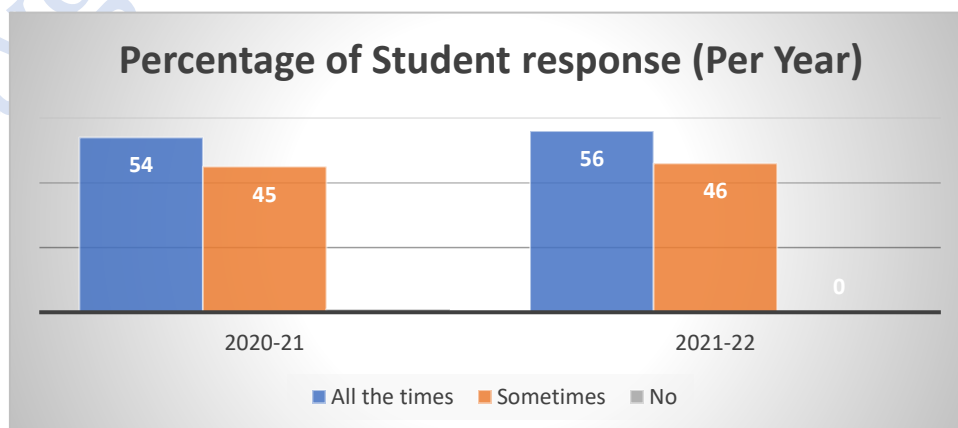

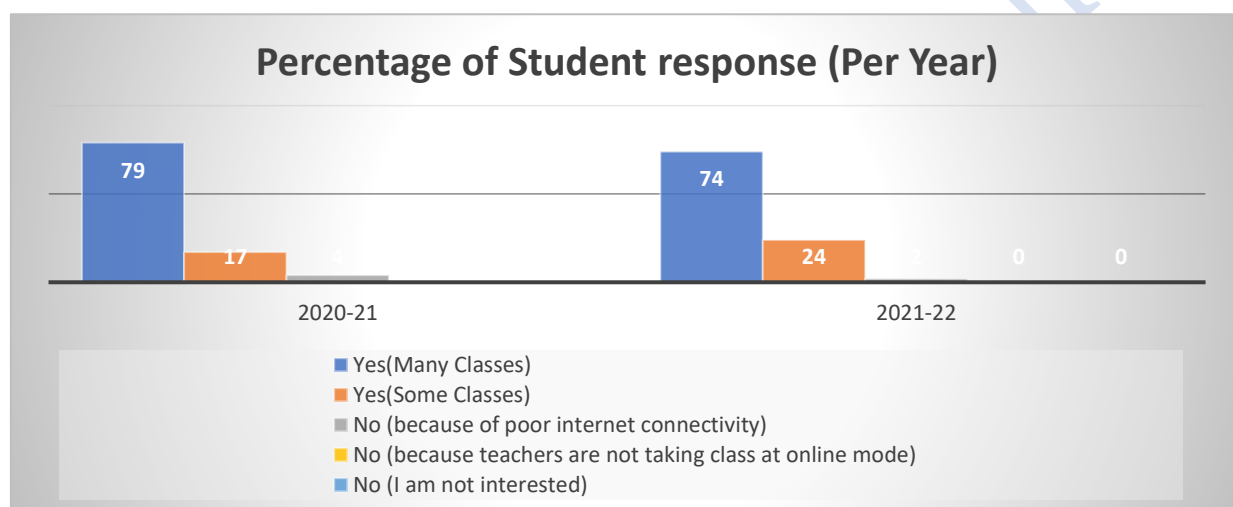
8. Do you have good internet access?

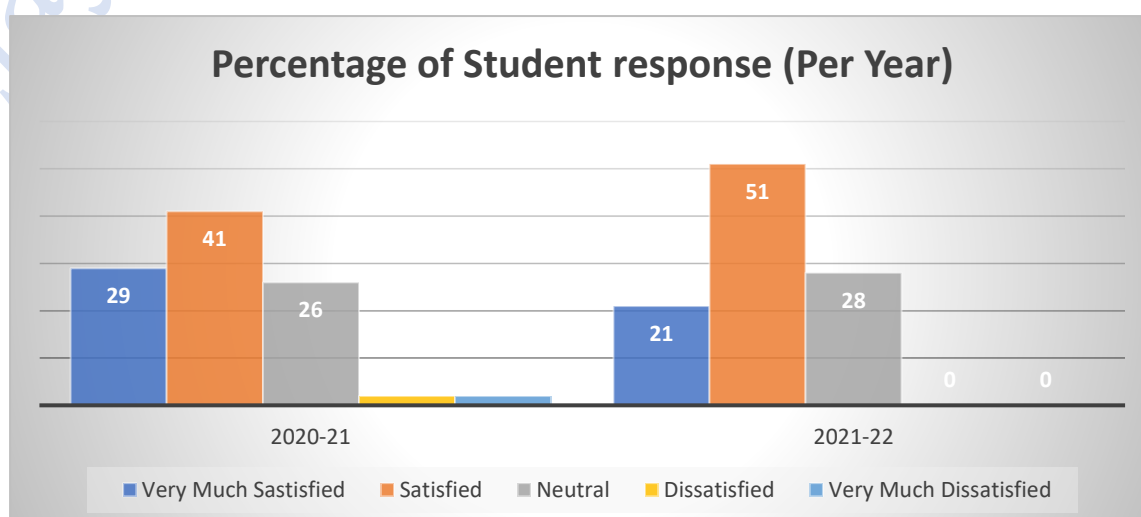

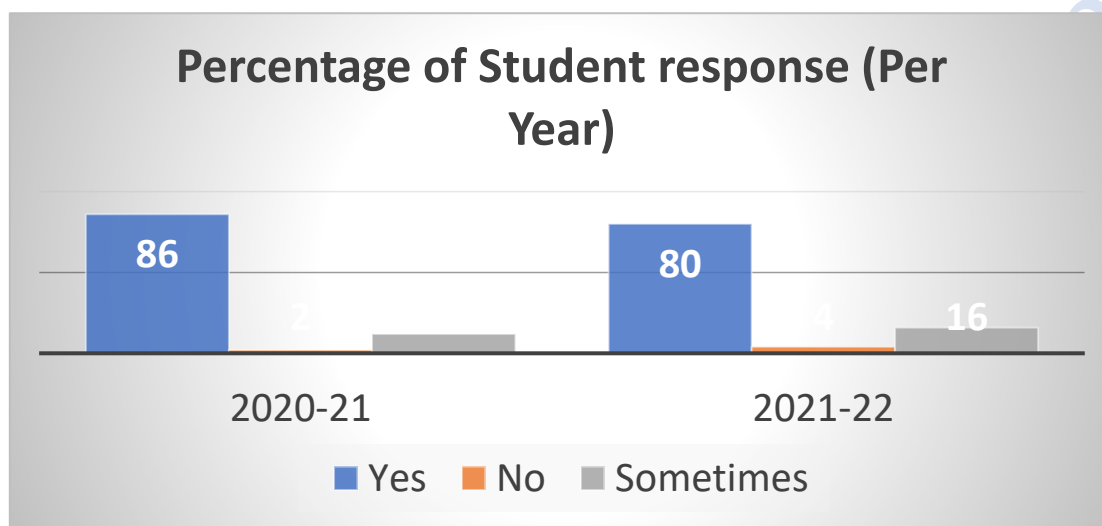
10. How satisfied are you regarding online classes using different online platforms?

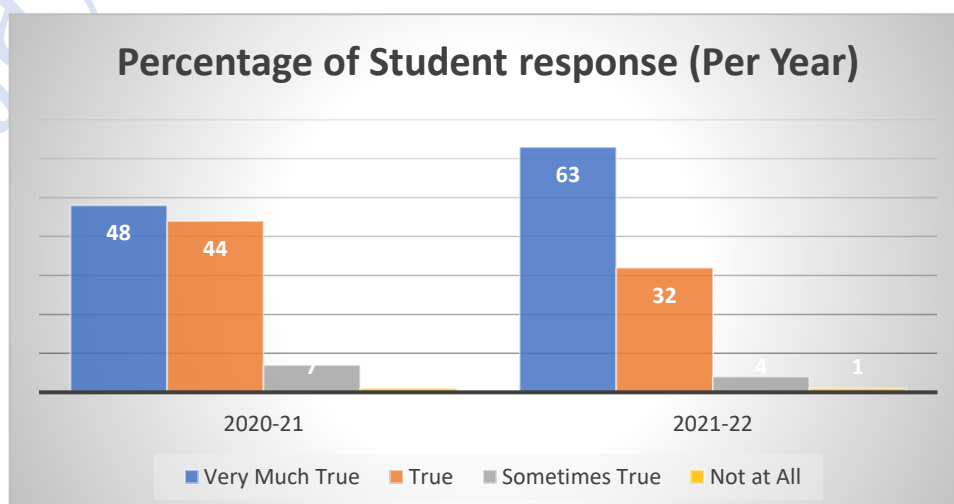
11. Were Online classes conducted regularly?

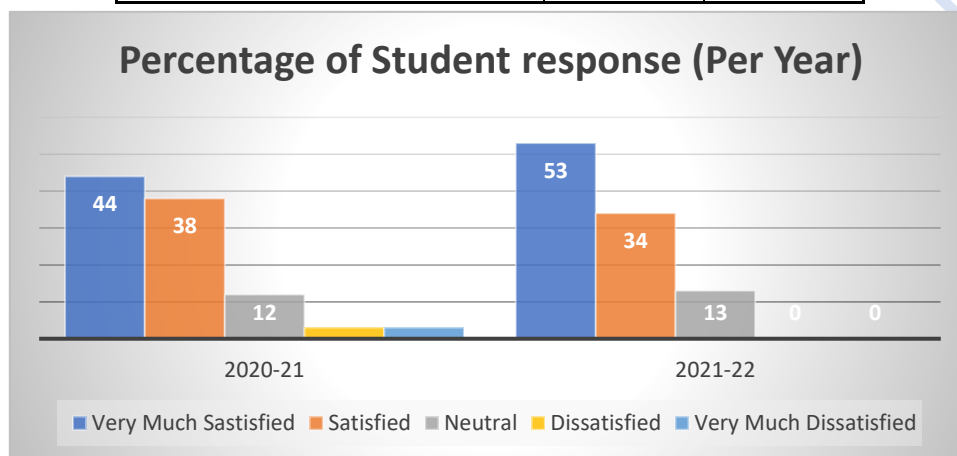
12. Do you think the online admission procedure of your college is fair and just?

ANALYSIS:

1. More than 60% students on an average reported that the communication skill of the college teachers were “very good” while around 30% of students responded “good”.
2. Most of the students reported that the syllabus was completed before exams thoroughly, although, there is a variation in scaling. For example, in 2021-22, 47% students responded "Very Good" to this question while 35 % responded good and 15% replied "Satisfactory".
3. Most of the student reported positively about the initiatives taken by the teachers in formulating test, quiz, exams, seminars, projects etc. For the example in 2021-22,

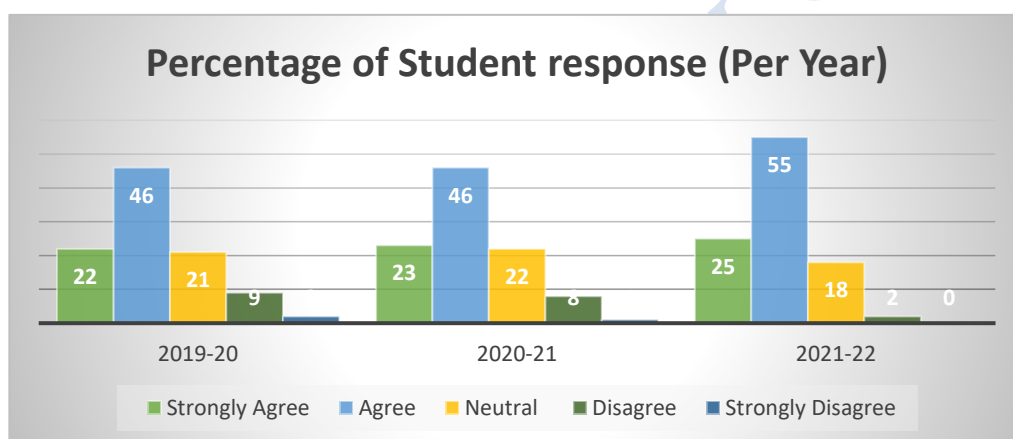
52% students strongly agreed with this view, 39% agreed the view and only 9% student remained neutral.

4. A total 93% student agreed (Out of which 50% strongly agreed) that class room were clean and well maintained.
5. 98% of students reported that clean drinking water is available in the college .
6. 91% of students reported that the toilets and washroom were properly cleaned in the college.
7. 91% student opined that the grievances/problems were redressed/resolved well in-time.
8. 55% of the students on an average reported that they have good internet access all the times, 45% of the students reported that they sometimes have good internet access.
9. More than 75% students participated in on-line class through Zoom, Google meet, Skype, TeamLink etc. whereas 20.5% students (on an average) participated in some classes through such online platforms . Around 3% Students have not participated in on-line classes because of poor internet connectivity in their localities.
10. Students in general were satisfied regarding on-line classes using different on-line platforms. In 2020-21, 41% of students were satisfied, whereas in 2021-22, 51% students were satisfied with online classes.
11. Around 83% of students reported that online classes were conducted regularly.
12. Most of the students believe that the on-line admission procedure of the college is fair and transparent.
13. Most of the students were very much satisfied with interaction and co-operation from the institution. In 2020-21, 44% of the students were reported that they were very much satisfied and 53% students reported the same in 2021-22.

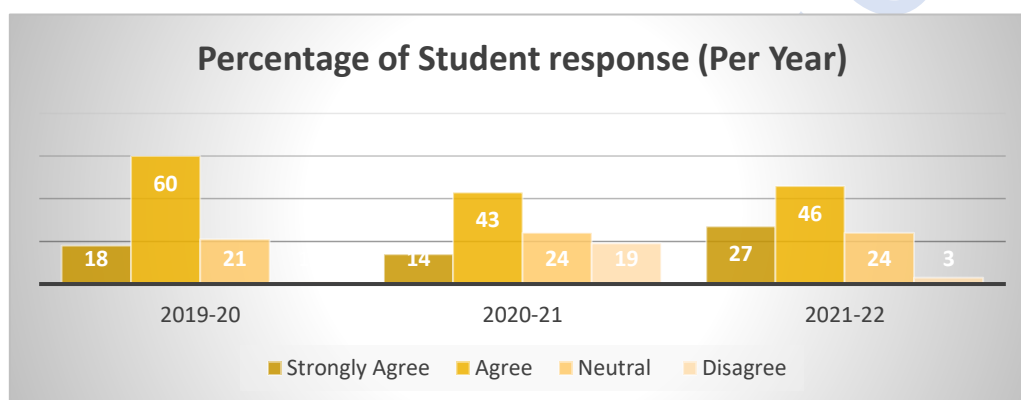
ANALYSIS-

1. Accessibility of textbooks and reference books from the college library through online/offline mode increases significantly. For example, in 2019-20, 68% of students reported that they can access library books and reference books via offline/online mode whereas that became 80 % in 2021-22.
2. Students can access the E-journal facility through INFLIBNET. It was noticed that the percentage of students utilizing the e-journal facility has increased significantly. For example, in 2019-20, 55% of students reported that they have accessed e-journal facility through INFLIBNET which became 77% in 2021-22.
3. Most of the students (more than 90%) reported that interaction with Librarian is very much friendly.
4. There is a sharp increase in accessing e-books from NDL. In the year, 2020-21, a total of 65 % of students agreed that they can access e-books from NDL whereas it became 90% in the year 2021-22.
5. A significant increase was observed in accessing E-books uploaded by the library on the college website. In the year 2021-22, a total of 91% of students agreed with this view whereas it was 73 % in the year 2020-21.
6. Students were also asked whether they can access the career guidance magazine of the library via online mode or not. In the year 2021-22, a total of 96% of the students responded that they can access the career guidance magazine of the library via online mode whereas it was a total of 67% in the year 2020-21.

ANALYSIS

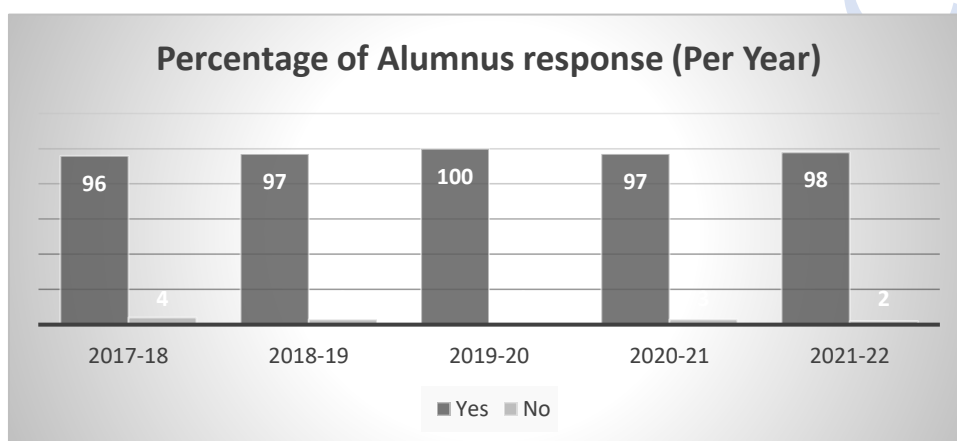
1. From the obtained data, it is inferred that 18% of students strongly agreed that the college has conducted Gender Sensitization Programmes as part of the curriculum in 2019-20 whereas 60% students agreed on this questions and 21% students remain neutral. In 2021-22, the percentage of students strongly agreeing increased to 27% and that of agreeing increased to 46%. The percentage of disagreement came down from 19% in 2020-21 (which may be due to Lockdown) to 3% in 2021-22.
2. The percentage of students who strongly agreed to the gender awareness programme conducted by the college in the year 2019-2020 was 23% and that of agreed was 56%. In 2020-2021 the percentage of students who strongly agreed and agreed are 14% to 43% respectively. In 2021-2022, it became 24% and 46% respectively. The percentage of students who disagreed with the fact declined from 19% in 2020-2021 to 6% in the year 2021-22 .
3. Data reveals that about three-fourth of the students were aware of the women's cell in the college, in the last three academic years (during 2019-2022).
4. The percentage of students who agreed to the setup of a grievance redressal cell in the year 2019-20 was 72% which increased to 76% in the year 2020-21 and further increased to 81% in 2021-22. From here we can say that the percentage of students aware or, agreed about the setup of the cell increased in the subsequent years.

5. The percentage of students who strongly agreed and simply agreed to the fact that the library offers equal opportunities to all gender were 47% and 50% respectively in the year 2019-20. In the year 2021-22, the percentage of students who agreed and strongly agreed were 45% and 52% respectively. Apart from the abnormal period (pandemic situation), one striking feature is that our students believe that college library offers equal opportunities to all genders.
6. From the obtained data, it can be said that on average 97.5% of students agreed the view that the college office offers equal opportunities to all genders in the year 2019-20 and 2021-22, whereas in the year 2020-21, 75% of students agreed the view of equal opportunities offered to all genders by the college office.

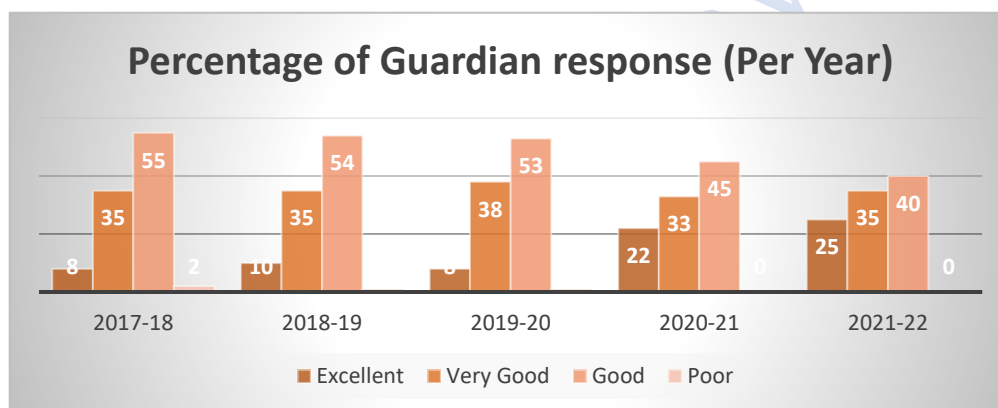
Analysis:

ANALYSIS

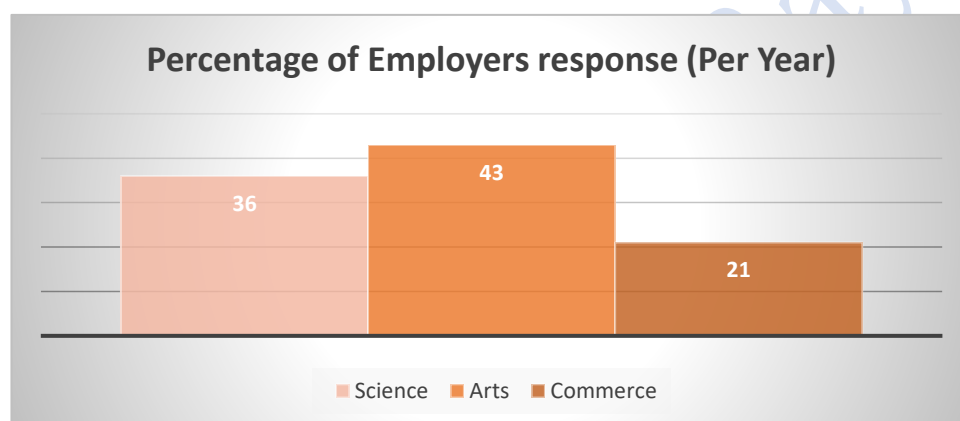
1. Over the years the campus atmosphere of VJRC improved considerably. All the guardians were found to be satisfied with the campus atmosphere.
2. Transparency of the online admission system gradually improved from 16% in 2017-18 to 32% in 2021-22.
3. All the guardians were satisfied with the quality of teaching. No one has reported the teaching quality as 'poor'.

4. Guardians were more or less satisfied with the regularity of classes. For example, in 2019-20, 40% of the guardians reported the regularity of classes as 'good', 30% reported it as 'very good' and the remaining 30% reported it as 'excellent'. Over the period 2017-2022, no guardian reported the regularity of the classes as 'poor'.
5. During the period 2017-18 to 2021-22, all the guardians reported about the online/offline library facility positively.
6. Guardians were also asked about the evaluation system of the college. 100% of guardians reported the evaluation system as either excellent or very good or good.
7. Guardians were merely satisfied with the co-operation of the college office staff.
8. During the pandemic situation (for the period 2020-21, 2021-22) no guardians were dissatisfied with the overall teaching-learning and co-operation from the college side.
9. College reputation and location are the two key factors for choosing Vijaygarh Jyotish Ray College as reported by the guardians.

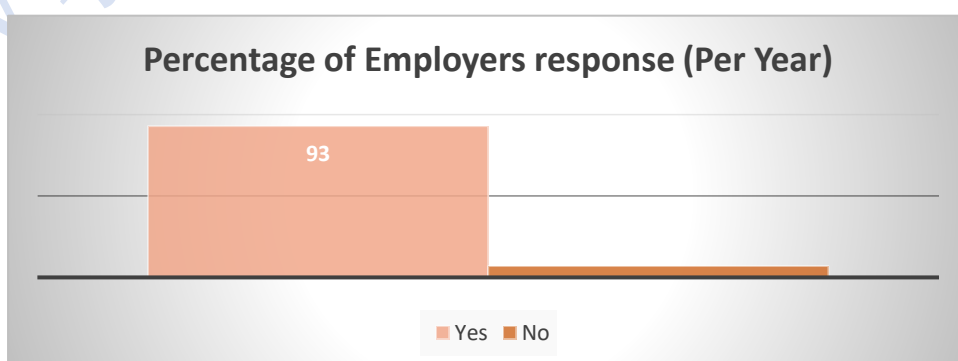

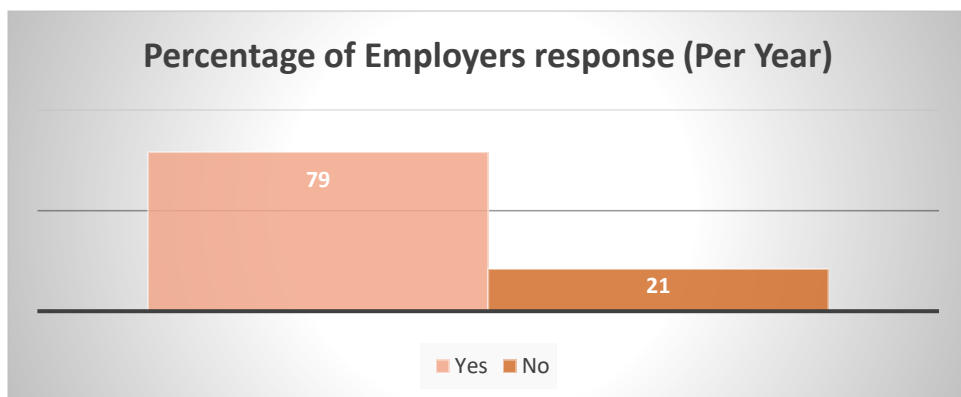
2. Do you think that curriculum of your desired stream is sufficient?

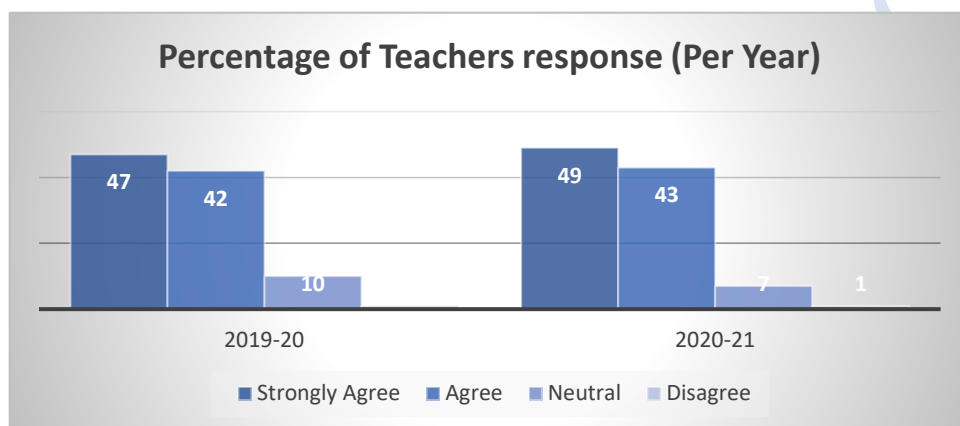

ANALYSIS

1. Most of the college teachers reported that institutions have given them full freedom to adopt new techniques or strategies of teaching such as group discussion/seminar/learner participation etc. Total 92% agreed the view in 2020-21 whereas that was 89% in 2019-20.
2. More than 80% teachers opined that the prescribe books or journals available in the college library are in sufficient numbers. In 2020-21, 86% teachers strongly agreed the view and it was 83% in the year 2019-20.
3. Most of the teachers viewed that the administration is teachers friendly. In 2020-21, 82% teachers strongly agreed the view.
4. More than 60% teachers strongly agreed that environment in the college is conducive to teaching and research purposes.
5. More than 80% teachers viewed that they have complete freedom to avail new techniques of testing/ assessment of students. In 2020-21, 87% teachers strongly agreed the view, whereas it was 82% in the year 2019-20.
6. In the year 2020-21, 90% of teachers strongly agreed that the test & examination are conducted well in time.

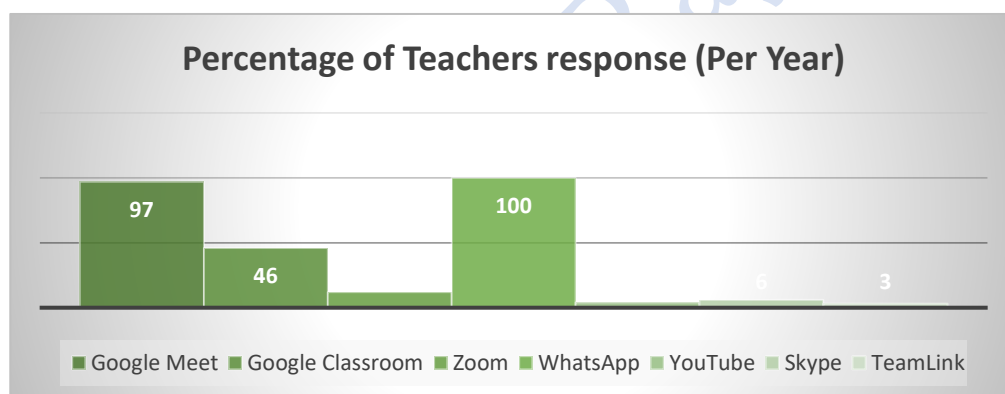
7. Most of the teachers agreed that the college provided adequate opportunities and support to faculties for upgrading their skills and qualifications. In the year 2020-21, 82% teachers strongly agreed the view.
8. As per opinion reported by the college teachers, the adequacy and the availability of ICT facilities in the college has increased. For example, 47% of teachers were strongly agreed with that view whereas it became 51% in the year 2020-21.
9. College Teachers were satisfied with the cleanliness and maintenance of toilets and washroom of the college. 82% teachers reported in the year 2019-20 that toilets and washrooms were clean and properly maintained whereas in 2020-21 total 85% teachers agreed with this view.
10. College Teachers were also satisfied with the cleanliness and good maintenance of the classrooms in the college. In the year 2019-20, total 84% teachers agreed in this case whereas in 2020-21 total 89% teacher agreed .
11. Most of the teachers reported that internet facilities are available in the college.
12. More than 75% teachers opined that the administrative and office staff are accessible and supportive.
13. Most of the teachers reported that the college provides adequate computer/ specimen /equipment/ chemical as per the requirements.
14. Most of the teachers were agreed the college premises are well maintained.
15. Most of the teachers strongly agreed (91% in the year 2019-20 and 96% in 2020-21) that the college Principal is supportive and accessible to all staff and students.
16. All the teachers reported that the salary disbursement in the college is on-time.
17. On the bases of reported data, it is inferred that the infrastructure of the college have improved over the years. In the year 2020-21, 67% college teachers reported that the college infrastructure was very good.

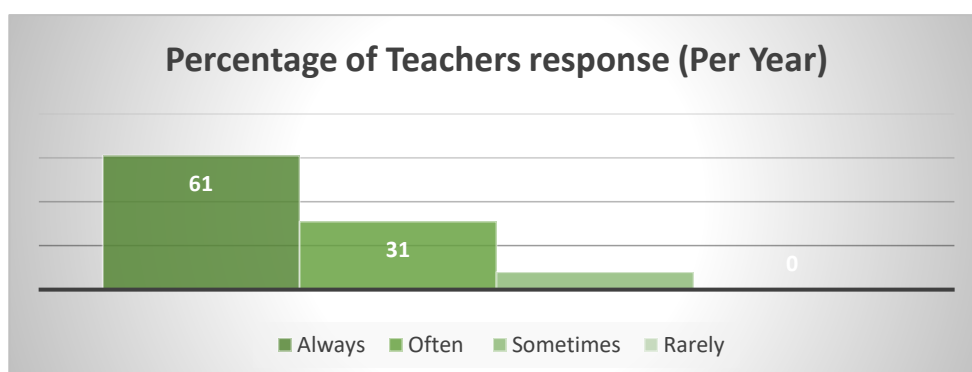

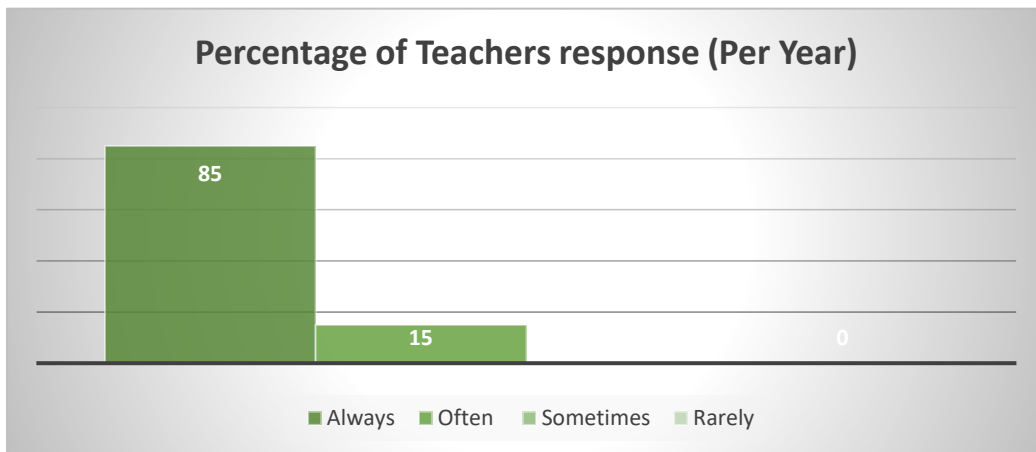

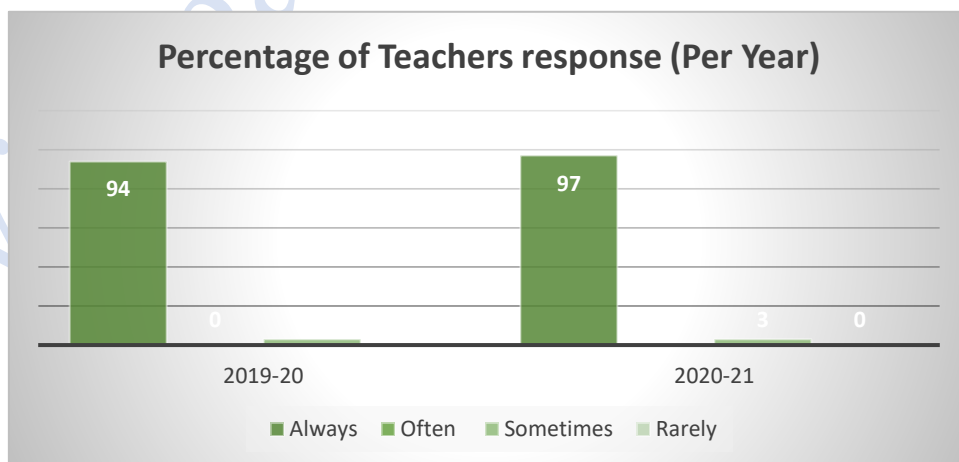
3. Do you welcome questions from students during your online classes?

ANALYSIS:

1. Teachers use multiple platforms (like Google Meet, Google Classroom, WhatsApp, Zoom, YouTube etc.) during Online Teaching. Mostly preferred platforms were WhatsApp, Google Meet, Google classroom and Zoom. Teachers give the notices and materials mostly through WhatsApp and Google Classrooms whereas online classes are taken through mainly Google Meet and Zoom. Limited useful online platforms were TeamLink, YouTube & Skype.
2. 61% of the teachers always provide e-learning materials. From the given information we can infer that the teachers were efficient enough and communicable in terms of supplying the study materials. Only the timelines of delivering the materials differ.
3. From the given data it is clear that the teachers welcomed questions from the students during their online classes. 85% of the teachers always welcomed the question. 15% of the teachers often answered the questions. From this we can infer that the teachers were efficient enough and easily approachable by the students.
4. Almost all the teachers (more than 93%) were always explain the topic they teach.
5. Data depicted that most of the teachers thoroughly prepare themselves before taking classes. During the year 2019-20, 79% of the teachers and during 2020-21, 82% of the teachers were found to be well prepared before taking classes. There were no such teachers who did not prepare before taking classes. This infers that the teachers were sincere and efficient enough in taking classes.
6. More than 70% teachers organized Quiz/Debate etc. in their class to evaluate the students' progress in a topic.
7. 90% and above syllabus were covered by almost all teachers.

8. All the teachers tried to identify and discuss the strength and weakness of their students. In 2020-21, 89% of teachers reported that they discuss the strength and weaknesses of their students regularly.
9. All the teachers tried to generate interest among the students about the subject. In 2020-21, 96% teachers always tried for it.
10. All the teachers encourage their students to take part in other creativities like Seminar/ Workshop/ Competitions. More than 90% teachers actively encourage their students to take part in other creativities.
11. 100% teachers allowed students to ask/discuss about their learning outside of class hours.
12. Majority of teachers organized seminars/webinars/workshops for the students per year.
13. All the teachers reported that they discuss the program and course outcomes with their students. In 2020-21, 96% teachers reported that they did this activity on a regular basis.
14. Most of the Teachers always inform and guide students about career opportunities. For example, in 2020-21, 99% teachers inform and guide the students about career opportunities. Only 1% teachers reported that sometimes they informed their students.
15. 99% teachers participated in the counselling/mentoring program for the students in each year. In 2020-21, 95% teachers regularly performed this type of activity.
16. All the teachers took initiative to motivate their students to relief them from the stress due to pandemic situation. In 2020-21, 92% of teachers successfully tried to motivate the students to get relief.
