

Report of activities and achevements of VJRC NCC unit during period June 2017-May 2018

Extension Activities carried out by NCC in session 2017-18

- 1. Voluntary blood donors are the cornerstone of a safe and adequate supply of blood and blood products. The safest blood donors are voluntary, non-remunerated blood donors from low-risk populations. In 2018-19 session a total of 27 and 2 NCC cadets of VJRC participated as volunteer blood donor at blood donation camp on 23.11.2017 and 05.04.2018 organized at Command Hospital, Kolkata.
- 2. 35, 20, 25 and 17 NCC cadets of the VJRC NCC Unit participated in mass awareness rally on "cleanliness drive" 2.12.2017, 3.12.2017, 8.12.2017 and 9.12.2017 respectively
- 3. 25 and 30 NCC cadets of the VJRC NCC Unit participated in "Nukkad Natak on Cleanliness Drive" on 5.12.2017 and 11.12.2017 respectively
- 4. 5 NCC cadets of the VJRC NCC Unit participated in National Cancer Awareness Day Rally on 7.11.2017
- 5. 20, 22 and 24 NCC cadets of the VJRC NCC Unit participated in different types of cleanliness drive like cleaning of streets, local hospital premises, back alleys, college campus and maintenance of statues of important personals of national importance on 6.12.2017, 10.12.2017 and 24.12.2017 respectively
- 6. National Youth Day, which honours Swami Vivekananda's birthday, encourages us to reflect on his writings and incorporate his principles into our own lives. Vivekananda's life and mission were an example to all, and his ideas are spread and discussed on National Youth Day. In 2017-18 session, 19 NCC cadets participated in Youth Day Rally on 12th January 2018 where ideas and principles of Swamiji were displayed for motivate the youth of this country
- 7. On 21.02.2018, 22 NCC cadets along with other students, faculty members, Non-teaching staffs, and NSS Volunteers of Vijaygarh Jyotish Ray College paid homage to the

- martyrs of language movement "Bhasha Andolan" on the Martyr's Altar st up at college premises and participated in a rally showcasing the cultural heritage of Bengal and later on the same day Department of Bengali organized an inter-departmental cultural competition and distributed certificate of participation and merit.
- 8. Safe drive safe life rally was aimed to develop NCC cadets as a national power, to make them think about development, in which road safety plays an important role. The objective of the rally was to bring the NCC cadets to the traffic road safety information to all the people. On 18.05.2018, 22 NCC cadets of VJRC NCC Unit participated in a road safely awareness rally that started from and ended at VJRC campus and went through the traffic busy roads around Bijoygarh and Ranikuthi area. At the rally, the NCC cadets were walking along holding road safety awareness placards in their hand.
